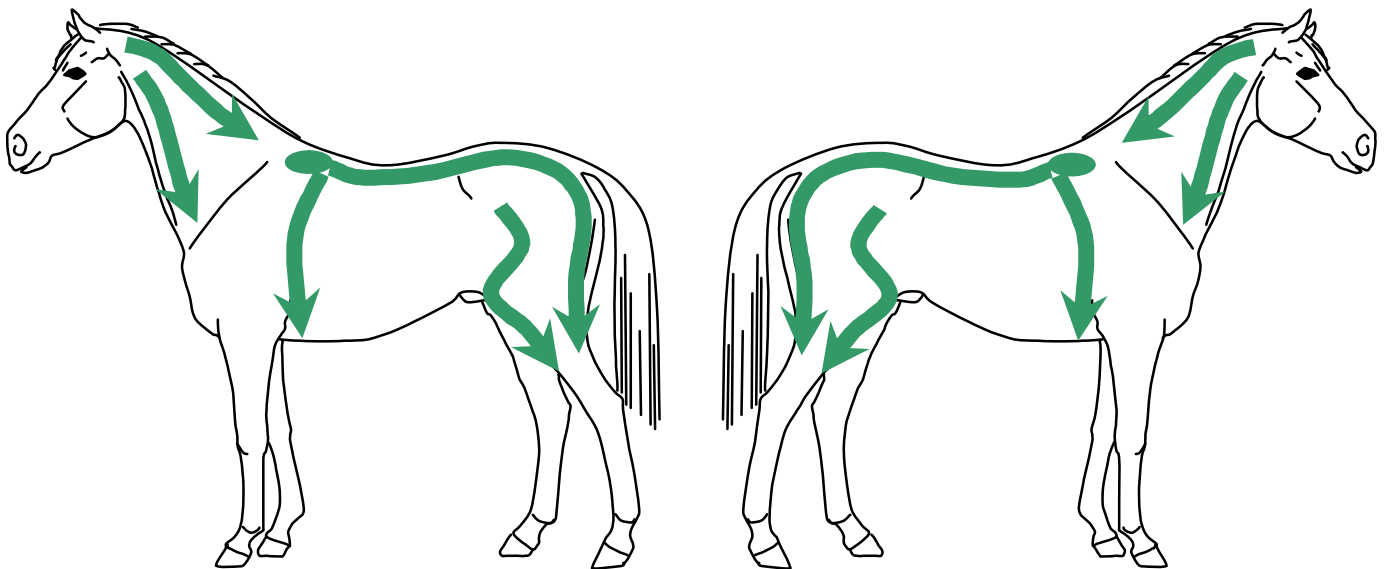


**Begin** your e.t. session  
**Read** the horse  
**Assess** with your hands  
**Note**  
**Differences**  
**Intent** established  
**Now**  
**Get going**

**Begin** all of your Equine Touch sessions by **reading** the horse's response to your presence, **assess** the horse's body by running your hands slowly over it and lifting each leg in turn, **note differences** that you find in temperature and texture. Once your **intent** has been established you can **now get going** with a body balance.



## Essential lines of 'branding'

Remember to keep two hands on as you go – you can keep one hand on the withers.

These are just suggested 'key' lines to follow as they cover the areas of the BBB – you can of course add to this if you need to
